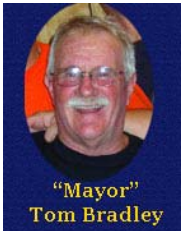

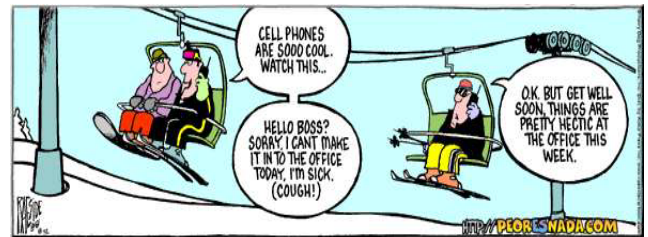
President's Message

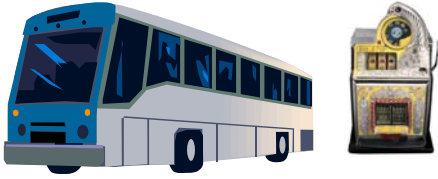
We also have Gift Cards for sale - they are sold at the face value, but the profits are currently allocated towards Post revitalization - we're starting with updating our restrooms!

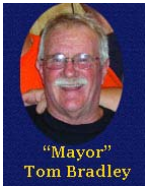
